Migrant workers, in particular EU citizens, have shown how workers are able to use mobility to quit poorly remunerated and precarious jobs to improve their economic conditions, and sharing such "mobility skills" and knowledge about EU labour market to exercise upwards occupational or sectoral exit.

Building on the fieldwork and interviews with migrant workers conducted at Foxconn electronics assembly plants in the Czech Republic and Slovakia, and on the findings of a research on posted workers in Italy, the seminar will illustrate processes of both segregation and mobilisation produced by intra-European mobility of labour in the manufacturing and services sectors.
